? How is joy talked about in culture today?

Possible Answers: Both are about giving praise to God. Joy is mentioned several times in both, and they both have very uplifting and joyous tones. Both talk about nature singing and praising. They both talk about God's righteousness.

? What does it look like to make music to the Lord?

Possible Answers: Thanking God for what he has done. Singing. Using the gifts God gave you to praise God.

? We all need to be saved by God and Jesus is the joy we need. How does God give you joy? *Possible Answers: His spirit works in my heart. His promises give me Hope. His unconditional love changes how I view myself and others. He gives my life purpose.*

? What joy do you crave?

Possible Answers: Answers will vary. Make a list of things I'm thankful for. Read the Psalms (or any part of the Bible). Journal. Talk to a friend. Listen to music. Talk to God. Look at the example of Jesus (read the gospels) and see how he handled pain and suffering. The key to this is a deep relationship with Jesus.
