



The error that we must emphatically repudiate is the often held notion that the gospel is the power of God only to get us converted. I once heard a missionary speaker report how a pastor in the mission field wrote to headquarters concerning his flock: ' We all know the gospel here, and now we must go on to something more solid.' The idea is that the gospel is the gateway to Christian experience, and thus to eternal life, but once we enter that gateway we move on to another more solid reality by which we progress...The point at issue is simply this. When we approach sanctification (i.e. living life in Christ) as attainable by any means other than the gospel of Christ – the same gospel by which we are converted – we have departed from the teaching of the New Testament.
