






"The heavy whip is brought down with full force again and again across Jesus' shoulders, back and legs. At first the heavy throngs cut through the skin only. Then as the blows continue they cut deeper into the subcutaneous tissues, producing first an oozing of blood from the capillaries and viens of the skin, and finally spurting arterial bleeding from vessels in the underlying muscles. The small balls of lead first produce large, deep bruises which are broken open by subsequent blows. Finally the skin of the back is hanging in long ribbons and the entire area is an unrecognizable mass of torn, bleeding tissue.
