









Azusa Street Revival – April 14th, 1906 through about 1915

2. Charismatic Renewal (1960s – present)

Holy Spirit power and experiences, but not a unified theology

(Mostly Mainline and Catholic)

Gave rise to three main “waves”

1. Pentacostalism (1900's – present)

Baptism in the Spirit = Speaking in Tongues

Usually Fundamentalistic in Theology

(Assemblies of God, Church of God, etc.)

2. Charismatic Renewal (1960s – present)

Holy Spirit power and experiences, but not a unified theology

(Mostly Mainline and Catholic)

3. “Third Wave” (1980s – present)

Evangelical in theology – Baptism of Spirit = Conversion

(John Wimber, Vineyard Churches founded, but spread to almost all evangelical churches)
