


If we are afflicted, it is for your comfort and salvation; and if we are comforted, it is for your comfort, which you experience when you patiently endure the same sufferings that we suffer.





In simple, godly living toward them 2 Corinthians 1:12



In refraining to visit them 2 Corinthians 1:16-17, 23



In writing to them 2 Corinthians 2:4


For I wrote to you out of much affliction and anguish of heart and with many tears, not to cause you pain but to let you know the abundant love that I have for you.





In choosing forgiveness for their sake 2 Corinthians 2:10-11



In preaching and teaching 2 Corinthians 2:16-17








Paul's ongoing defense of ministry

Therefore, having this ministry by the mercy of God, we do not lose heart.






Paul's ongoing defense of ministry






