



Exodus 24

¹² The LORD said to Moses, “Come up to me on the mountain and stay here, and I will give you the tablets of stone with the law and commandments I have written for their instruction.”

¹³ Then Moses set out with Joshua his aide, and Moses went up on the mountain of God....¹⁵ When Moses went up on the mountain, the cloud covered it, ¹⁶ and the glory of the LORD settled on Mount Sinai. For six days the cloud covered the mountain, and on the seventh day the LORD called to Moses from within the cloud.





What was Peter thinking? Perhaps it was just a courteous reflex. Maybe he wanted to make thatched booths for his heavenly visitors, so he, James, and John could wait on them. Certainly in Jewish thinking such booths were joyous symbols. Others think it was a simple attempt to prolong the amazing conversation.⁵ However, had Jesus complied, Peter's unfortunate suggestion would have placed all three figures on the same level, not to mention that it would have impeded the plan for salvation, planned from eternity. Peter was confused at best. Jesus chose not to answer. But an unforgettable answer was in the air.

Jesus' Identity is made clear.




Coronation of a Hebrew King

Hebrews 1:1-4

In the past God spoke to our ancestors through the prophets at many times and in various ways, 2 but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom also he made the universe. 3
