John 8:12

¹²When Jesus spoke again to the people, he said, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."

Summary of "The weird conversation..."

I am then light of the world (8:12)

<u>Objection</u> Hey, you don't have enough people in the witness stand! (8:13)

> Answer to Objection Do the math! (8:14-18)

<u>**Response to the Objection**</u> Who's your daddy? (8:19-20)

Summary of "The weird conversation..."

Statement #2:

I am leaving, and when I do, you will die in your sin because you cannot follow me. (8:21)

> <u>Super confused response:</u> Are you going to kill yourself? (8:22)

Statement restated with superior clarity (8:23-24)

Response to the restatement: Who are you? (8:25a)

Jesus clarification to them once again (8:25b-29)

Summary of "The weird conversation..."

Yet, in spite of all this confusion, people actually respond positively to Jesus

³⁰Even as he spoke, many put their faith in him. (John 8:30)

"Conversation of the Weird" resumes...

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John 8:31-32

³¹To the Jews who had believed him, Jesus said, "If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. ³²Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."

Becoming a true disciple of Jesus

John 8:31-32

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The benefits of following Jesus

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Freedom?!?! Are we slaves?!?!?

John 8:33

³³They answered him, "We are Abraham's descendants and have never been slaves of anyone. How can you say that we shall be set free?"

Jesus' answer, "You are in deep slavery...to sin!"

John 8:34-36

³⁴Jesus replied, "I tell you the truth, everyone who sins is a slave to sin. ³⁵Now a slave has no permanent place in the family, but a son belongs to it forever. ³⁶So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed.

Romans 6:6-23

⁶For we know that our old self was crucified with him so that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves to sin – ⁷because anyone who has died has been freed from sin. ⁸Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him. ⁹For we know that since Christ was raised from the dead, he cannot die again; death no longer has mastery over him. ¹⁰The death he died, he died to sin once for all; but the life he lives, he lives to God.

Romans 6:6-23

¹¹In the same way, count yourselves dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus. ¹²Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body so that you obey its evil desires. ¹³Do not offer the parts of your body to sin, as instruments of wickedness, but rather offer yourselves to God, as those who have been brought from death to life; and offer the parts of your body to him as instruments of righteousness. ¹⁴For sin shall not be your master, because you are not under law, but under grace.

Romans 6:6-23

¹⁵What then? Shall we sin because we are not under law but under grace? By no means! ¹⁶Don't you know that when you offer yourselves to someone to obey him as slaves, you are slaves to the one whom you obey – whether you are slaves to sin, which leads to death, or to obedience, which leads to righteousness?
¹⁷But thanks be to God that, though you used to be slaves to sin, you wholeheartedly obeyed the form of teaching to which you were entrusted. ¹⁸You have been set free from sin and have become slaves to righteousness.

Romans 6:6-23

¹⁹I put this in human terms because you are weak in your natural selves. Just as you used to offer the parts of your body in slavery to impurity and to ever-increasing wickedness, so now offer them in slavery to righteousness leading to holiness. ²⁰When you were slaves to sin, you were free from the control of righteousness. ²¹What benefit did you reap at that time from the things you are now ashamed of? Those things result in death! ²²But now that you have been set free from sin and have become slaves to God, the benefit you reap leads to holiness, and the result is eternal life. ²³For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
