Romans 2:12-16 12 For all who have sinned without the law will

also perish without the law, and all who have sinned under the law will be judged by the law. ¹³ For it is not the hearers of the law who are righteous before God, but the doers of the law who will be justified. ¹⁴ For when Gentiles, who do not have the law, by nature do what the law requires, they are a law to themselves, even though they do not have the law.

Romans 2:12-16

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All will be judged by their actions. It is likely that Paul is arguing against the assumption that Jews will have some special benefit toward salvation. Rather, Gentiles will be judged on the revelation given them, as will the Jews. Because the Jews were given the law through Moses, they will be held to that standard. The Gentiles are accountable to the law of their conscience."

Romans 1:32 "God's little 'l' law"

³² Though they know God's righteous decree that those who practice such things deserve to die, they not only do them but give approval to those who practice them.



Romans 2:12-16

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Everyone is trying to earn their salvation. "Works righteousness" – the attempt to justify yourself by works of the law (be their actions or attributes) – is the default mode of human operation, not just a select few who identify as religious. The law reigns over all creation; the question is not if but which form a person subscribes to. 'Performancism' is a helpful way to describe what it looks like to justify ourselves...

In a performance paradigm, there is no distinction between our résumé and our identity. Our performance – in whatever realm we value most – is not just descriptive of us, it is us. It might be a bank balance, or a weight scale, church attendance records or college admissions results, but if you are not doing (and doing well), your very life is at stake, to say nothing of your dignity or well-being."
