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The twisted fallenness of the human heart manifests itself in our constant self-atonement strategies. The natural, default mode of the human heart (including the Christian heart) is restless heart-wandering, looking for something to latch on to for significance, to know we matter, to feel okay about ourselves. This tendency is often profoundly subtle and extremely difficult to root out. We are sinners. We are sick. Gospel-centeredness, then ... acknowledges that the good news about God's grace in Christ is the supreme resource – for believers just as much for unbelievers.

In other words, the gospel is a home, not a hotel. It is not only the gateway into the Christian life, but the pathway of the Christian life. This is why Paul constantly reminds people – reminds Christian people – of the gospel. We move forward in discipleship not mainly through pep talks and stern warnings. We move forward when we hear afresh the strangeness of grace, relaxing our hearts and loosening our clenched hold on a litany of lesser things – financial security, the perfect spouse, career advancement, sexual pleasure, human approval, and so on."




