



Main characters & Setting

Genesis 4:1-2

¹ Now Adam knew Eve his wife, and she conceived and bore Cain, saying, "I have gotten a man with the help of the LORD." ² And again, she bore his brother Abel. Now Abel was a keeper of sheep, and Cain a worker of the ground.



"The name Cain sounds similar to the Hebrew word for 'I have gotten'—he's literally named 'the one I have gotten.' Eve's excitement is evident: Cain, this 'acquired one,' is the seed God has promised. Adam and Eve soon have a second son and name him Abel (Gen. 4:2)...In Ecclesiastes, 'Abel' is the book's most prominent word; it's translated 'vanity.' Eve already has her 'acquired one' who will crush the serpent and restore her to paradise, so why had God given her another son? Abel seems pointless. He is the 'worthless one.'"

Rising Action: God's Disregard for Cain's Offering


Genesis 4:3–7


³ In the course of time Cain brought to the LORD an offering of the fruit of the ground, ⁴ and Abel also brought of the firstborn of his flock and of their fat portions. And the LORD had regard for Abel and his offering, ⁵ but for Cain and his offering he had no regard. So Cain was very angry, and his face fell. ⁶ The LORD said to Cain, "Why are you angry, and why has your face fallen? 7 If you do well, will you not be accepted? And if you do not do well, sin is crouching at the door. Its desire is contrary to you, but you must rule over it."



When we observe Cain stalking off, slamming the church door behind him, and brooding over his wounded ego, we are keenly aware of him inhabiting our world. Inwardly, his anger storms. Outwardly, his countenance falls. He wears his soiled soul on his face. The one thing that would make all the difference in his world—God's approval, God's acceptance he does not have. So, he sets out to make a world of his own in defiance of God...Cain's heart is restless, so he invents his own resting places: anger, bitterness, malice, self-pity.






Cain's Offering or Cain's Heart?




Is Jesus' blood your forgiveness?
