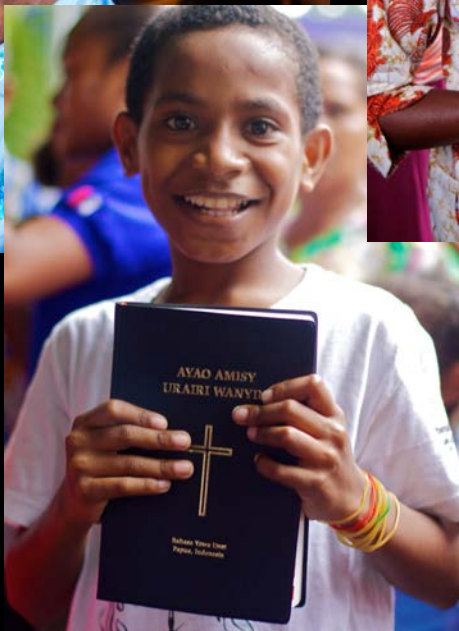

- Many different words used to refer to scripture: law, testimonies, precepts, statutes, commandments, rules/ordinances, word, and promise.

God's Word is Trustworthy and Righteous

142 - Your righteousness is everlasting and your law is true.

160 - All your words are true; all your righteous laws are eternal.

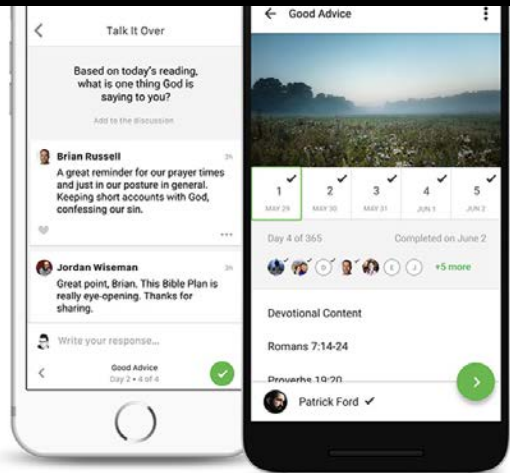

“God has perfectly expressed himself in two ways...God’s word as text is perfect...but God’s word as text wasn’t sufficient to completely express who he is to the world...not only God’s word has to come in the form of text, but God’s word must also come in the form of flesh...

The word made text can’t save you by itself...Every prophet, every priest, every king is pointing to Jesus. You read the temple and the sacrifices, but the ultimate sacrifice is Jesus. You read about the kings and the prophets - the ultimate king and the ultimate prophet is Jesus...

The word made text is about the word made flesh and when you only see the word made text and don't realize it's all about Jesus then it would be legalism and to obey it would just crush you because you'd never live up to it, but when you realize that the word made text is actually about the word made flesh then you suddenly realize that everything in the Bible is really about him and what he's done to save you."

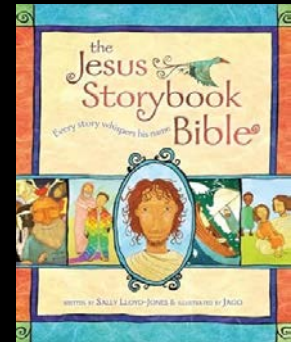
⁵¹ With that, one of Jesus' companions reached for his sword, drew it out and struck the servant of the high priest, cutting off his ear.

⁵² "Put your sword back in its place," Jesus said to him, "for all who draw the sword will die by the sword. ⁵³ Do you think I cannot call on my Father, and he will at once put at my disposal more than twelve legions of angels? ⁵⁴ But how then would the Scriptures be fulfilled that say it must happen in this way?"

Now, some people think the Bible is a book of rules, telling you what you should and shouldn't do. The Bible certainly does have some rules in it. They show you how life works best. But the Bible isn't mainly about you and what you should be doing. It's about God and what he has done....

There are lots of stories in the Bible, but all the stories are telling one Big Story. The Story of how God loves His children and comes to rescue them. It takes the whole Bible to tell this Story. And at the center of the Story, there is a baby. Every story in the Bible whispers His name. He is like the missing piece in the puzzle-the piece that makes all the other pieces fit together, and suddenly you can see a beautiful picture."
