


Isaiah "was more of an Evangelist than a Prophet, because he described all of the Mysteries of the Church of Christ so vividly that you would assume he was not prophesying about the future, but rather was composing a history of past events.



Three different aspects to prophecy:

The "pointing arrow, predictive" element to prophecy (Isaiah 53)

The "typological" element to prophecy (Jonah 1-4, Daniel 6)

The "fading shadow" element to prophecy (Isaiah 43): the prophets anticipate the future in light of God's saving activity in the past, and spiritualize it.

The fading shadow element to prophecy

OT history	Prophets' message	NT fulfillment
Creation	A new creation is coming	Jesus
Exodus	A new exodus is coming	Jesus
Law/Temple	A new law and temple is coming	Jesus
David	A new David is coming	Jesus
Return to the land	A new return is coming	Jesus

Today's Sermon: "Light up the Darkness" Passage: Isaiah 9:1-2 & Matthew 4:12-17


1. God's Light

Genesis 1:1-4

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. ² Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters.

³ And God said, "Let there be light," and there was light.

⁴ God saw that the light was good, and he separated the light from the darkness.










God's Light God's Light on Earth


Isaiah 9:1-2

Nevertheless, there will be no more gloom for those who were in distress. In the past he humbled the land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, but in the future he will honor Galilee of the nations, by the Way of the Sea, beyond the Jordan—

¹² When Jesus heard that John had been put in prison, he withdrew to Galilee. ¹³ Leaving Nazareth, he went and lived in Capernaum, which was by the lake in the area of Zebulun and Naphtali—¹⁴ to fulfill what was said through the prophet Isaiah:



Revelation 21:1-4

Then I saw "a new heaven and a new earth," for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and there was no longer any sea. ² I saw the Holy City, the new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride beautifully dressed for her husband. ³ And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Look! God's dwelling place is now among the people, and he will dwell with them. They will be his people, and God himself will be with them and be their God. 4'He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death' or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away."
