

Question 37

47 and that repentance for the forgiveness of sins should be proclaimed in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem. 48 You are witnesses of these things. **49 And behold, I am sending the promise of my Father upon you.** But stay in the city until you are clothed with power from on high."




Acts 2:32-33



"The Holy Spirit indwelling the individual Christian is not only the agent of Christ, but he is also the agent of the Father. Consequently, when I accept Christ as my savior, my guilt is gone, I am indwelt by the Holy Spirit, and I am in communication with the Father, and the Son, as well as of the Holy Spirit--the entire Trinity. Thus now, in the present life, if I am justified, I am in a personal relationship with each of the members of the Trinity. God the Father is my Father; I am in union with the Son; and I am indwelt by the Holy Spirit. This is not just meant to be doctrine; it is what I have now."

Romans 5:5-8


