Hope Downtown Small Groups

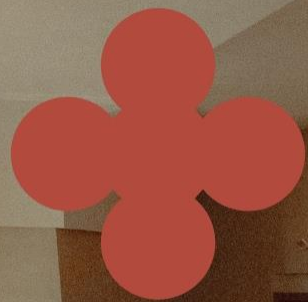

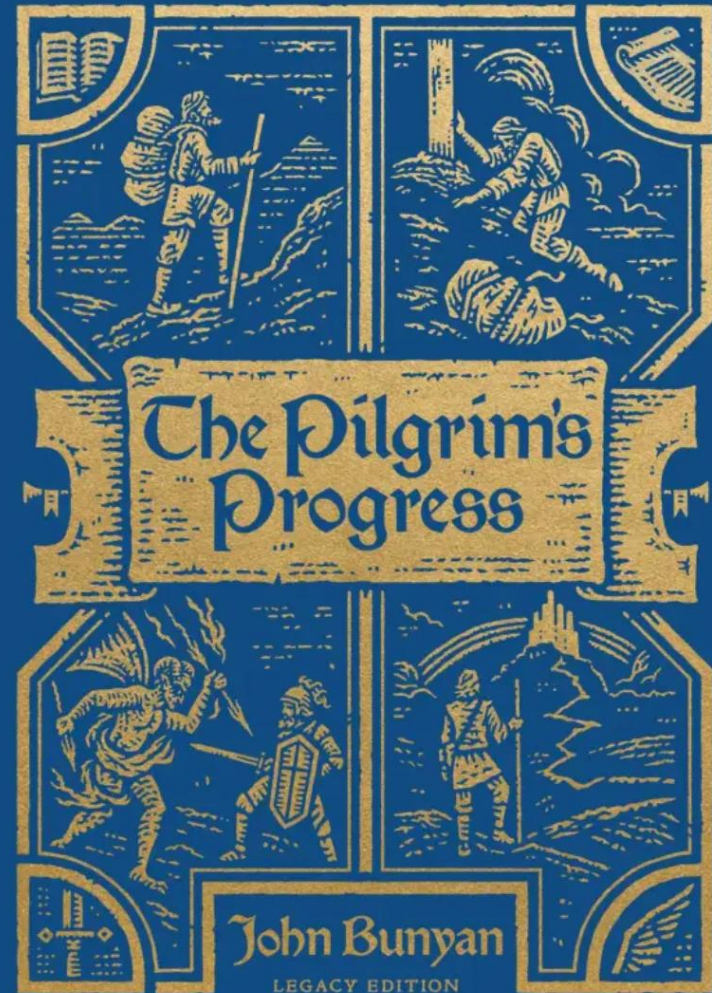
